

Note 2: Direction no. 12 of 2017 dated April 27, 2017 requires AMCs to exclude the amount invested by fund of fund schemes in underlying funds managed by the same AMC while publishing the amount of assets under its management in advertisements. Accordingly, if the amount invested by fund of fund schemes in underlying funds of the same AMC (which is Rs52,620 million) is deducted from AUMs of the industry, the total assets under management of the industry amounted to the tune of Rs610,406 million, as of November 30, 2017.





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






Trend of Total Assets of Conventional and Shariah Compliant Mutual Funds & Plans














Trend of Total Assets of Discretionary / Non-Discretionary Portfolios

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




