		I have observed that the Respondents have failed to provide written response or avail numerous hearing opportunities provided to justify their stance regarding violation of the provisions of Section 183 of the Act. Therefore, I am constrained to conclude the proceedings based on the information available on record.
		I have gone through the fact of the case and observed that provisions of Section 183 of the Act require a company to obtain prior authorization of the members in general meeting either specifically or by way of an authorization to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of the undertakings or sizable part thereof. The Company has disposed off sizeable part of its P&M without taking shareholders' approval which violation of subsection (3) of Section 183 of the Act. From the above discussion and after careful consideration of all the facts of the case, I am of the view that provisions of sub-section (3) of Section 183 of the Act have been contravened and for this

			 contravention, the Respondents are liable under the sub-section (6) of Section 183 of the Act. In exercise of the powers conferred under the said provision. Penalty order dated July 06, 2021 was passed by Director/HoD (Adjudication-I).
