**CASE No. 921/2022**

**BEFORE THE ADJUDICATING OFFICER**

**ORDER UNDER SECTION 21 READ WITH SECTION 479 OF THE COMPANIES ACT, 2017**

IN THE MATTER OF **MESSRS. WA FATIMA ENTERPRISES (SMC-PRIVATE) LITIED**

**Present:** None present for hearing nor any written response received from the company or its management.



1. This Order shall dispose of the proceedings initiated under Section 21 of the Companies Act, 2017 ("The Act"), vide Show Cause Notice dated 27-June-22 ("the Notice").
2. The facts of the case are that, a complaint against the company was lodged at Prime Minister's Performance Delivery Unit (PMDU). The contents indicate that the company is engaged in unauthorized business activities viz. collection of money from the general public on the pretense of vehicle financing. As per records, the company did not notify the registrar of the situation of its registered office. Therefore, the complaint was directed to the company at the correspondence address for seeking its clarification. However, that was returned undelivered. An official of SECP was deputed to ascertain the factual position. However, it was reported by him that the registered office address does not exist at the given premises.
3. The aforesaid facts depicts that the company has, prima facie, either failed to have its registered office address or failed to give notice of change of registered office address to the registrar, as the case may be, in violation of the Sub-Section (1) or Subsection (2) of Section 21 of the Companies Act, 2017 (the "Act") and Sub-Section (1) of Section 21 of the Act provides a company have a registered office to which all communications and notices shall be addressed and sub-section (2) ibid provides that the company shall give notice to the Registrar for change of registered office addresses in the manner provided therein.
4. The aforesaid violation attracts the penal provisions of sub-section-3 of section-21 of the Act which provides that any violation of Section-21 (1) or (2) shall be an offense liable to a penalty of Level-1 of the standard scale, i-e up-to Rs.25,000/- and upto Rs.500/- per day during which default continues, as provided u/s 479(2) of the Act. Accordingly, taking cognizance of the matter, a Show Cause Notice dated 27-06-22 was served to the company through its Chief Executive as well as the directors of the company, calling upon them to Show Cause in my office on 07-07-2022 subsequently adjourned to 18-07-2022 and 27-07-2022, as to why the penalty laid down under the above mentioned section should not be imposed.

5. However, in response to the above-mentioned show cause notice, neither anyone appeared before the undersigned for personal hearing nor any written reply was received from the subject company. In order to provide further opportunity of being heard and to meet the end of justice, two reminders / re-scheduled notices were also served upon the company. Yet, no response in any manner received from or on behalf of the company or its management, the undersigned is left with no choice but to take an ex-parte decision on the basis of the record maintained by the company registration office (CRO-Karachi) as required under the "Act". Henceforth, I hereby impose the penalty as under:

6. The management of the company is advised to deposit the penalty amount within 15 days from the date of receipt of this order in any designated branches of MCB Bank Limited or UBL Bank and furnish original receipted challan to this office within the above said period and also directed to have a register office address immediately but not later than 30 days from the date of receipt of this order positively under intimation to the concerned/dealing registrar.
7. A copy of this order be placed on the record/file of the company for future reference and further appropriate action to be taken by the concerned registrar, if any.
