		I have gone through the facts of the case in light of the relevant
		provisions of the Act, the information available on record, and state
		that it is mandatory for a listed company to have at least two or one
		third of its members as independent directors as required under
		Regulations 6 of the CCG Regulations. It is also mandatory to have
		at least three members on the Board Audit Committee with at least
		one independent director and Chairman of the Board Audit
		Committee is required to be an independent director, and the
		Chairman of the Board shall not be the Chairman of the Audit
		Committee. In the instant case, it was observed that the Respondents
		failed to appoint requisite number of independent directors on its
		board and audit committee, however, the said defaults are now
		rectified and the Company has complied with Regulation 6 and 27
		of the CCG Regulations. Therefore, I in terms of power conferred
		under Regulation 37 of the CCG Regulations read with Section 512
		of the Act hereby conclude the proceedings initiated through the
		SCN without imposing any monetary penalty. The Respondents are
		however, warned to ensure compliance with all the regulatory
		requirements including Regulations 6 and 27 of the CCG
		Regulations in letter and spirit, in future.
