S.R.O. 543 (1)/2015.- In exercise of power conferred under section 505 of the Companies Ordinance, 1984 (XLVII of 1984), read with section 470 thereof and clause (c) of section 43 of the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan Act, 1997 (XLII of 1997) and S.R.O. 698 (I)/86, dated 2nd July 1986, the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan is hereby pleased to make the following amendments in the Sixth Schedule as notified vide S.R.O. 996(I)/2010 dated October 26, 2010 to the said Ordinance, namely:-

AMENDMENT

In the said Schedule, in Item (I), –


- (i) after sub-clause (iii) of clause (2) the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:

"Provided that a company which is wholly owned by the Federal Government and has been notified by the Federal Government in the official Gazette for exemption from paying fee shall be charged a fee of Rs. 10,000/-"; and

- (ii) after clause (3) after the explanation, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:

"Provided that a company which is wholly owned by the Federal Government and has been notified by the Federal Government in the official Gazette for exemption from paying fee shall be charged a fee of Rs. 10,000/- irrespective of share capital."
