SEC holds Training Workshop for Registrars at Karachi

Islamabad – January 18, 2005: The Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SEC) organized a two-day in-house training workshop in Karachi for the Registrars of the Company Registration Offices (CROs) of Karachi, Quetta and Sukkur.

The focus of the workshop was to familiarize the registrars with their role in facilitating Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) in statutory compliance as well as in corporatization. The SEC is keen to promote corporate culture in the SME sector.
