SEC Sets up Registration Camp Office at RCCI

Islamabad – September 2, 2005: In order to facilitate registration of companies, the Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SEC) has established a registration camp office at the Rawalpindi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (RCCI).

The registration camp was inaugurated in a meeting between the Registrar of Companies, Mr. Nazir Ahmed Shaheen and the RCCI President, Mr. Najam Rehan at RCCI office in Rawalpindi.

An officer of the Company Registration Office (CRO) Islamabad would visit the camp office on the first Thursday of each month to register companies. The objective is to facilitate the business community in registration of companies besides providing necessary guidance in this regard.

On the occasion, the Registrar of Companies also highlighted the various steps taken by the SEC to encourage corporatisation and to evolve an efficient and easy incorporation procedure at CROs. The RCCI President appreciated the move saying that it would encourage the members of the business community to register their companies with the SEC.
