ISLAMABAD, December 27: In its endeavor to develop a fair, efficient and transparent

corporate sector and to safeguard the interests of investors as well as the general public, the

Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP) shall continue to extend complete

cooperation to law enforcement agencies (LEAs) for the cause of transparency.

The Federal Investigation Agency (FIA), on Wednesday evening had approached the SECP and
